

Ugandans to the rescue

Remember **Munansi news paper** routinely reported countless lorries and trucks full of Obote's soldiers blown up by Museveni's rebels in Luwero the fact Museveni never disputed, again there is no evidence that either Obote or Museveni ever buried those dead soldier! ***Today we see a piles and piles of skulls in Luwero piled by Museveni along the road portraying them to be innocent civilians killed by Obote***
