FACTS THE BANYAMULENGE's strategies

In May 1985 the National Resistance Army high command composed of Yoweri Museven Salim Sareh, Fred Rwegyema, David Tinye Funza, Jim Muhezi, Paul Kagame Moses Kigongo kizza Bisigye and Kahinda Otafire formed a committee which will fight a war in Rwanda soon after the National Resistance Army had taken over the Okello regime.

Fred Rwegyema was to be the overall commander. David Tinye funza was to be the operation commander, Mugisha Muntu the Assistant operation commander, Jim Muhezi the intelligence commander. Paul Kagame the operations co-ordinators. Shef Ali was put in charge of recruiting and organising all Batusi and Bahima in all refugee camps and centres mainly Kyaka, Kahungi, Rwimi, Ibuga and base camp. Matteka was in charge of administration and management of all these trainees.

Byensi was in charge of supplies and well fair. Biganja was in charge of all training at Rwenzori Mountain Barracks known as (Mulima Barracks) all Batusi and Bahima were trained in this isolated military barracks to avoid the leakage of their motive. By the end of 1985 more than three thousand Batusi and Bahima were ready trained in all military fields that is weapons, parade, intelligence and political.

After taking over power Jan 86 Museven called Habyalimana to be the guest of honour and to award military ranks to him and other senior commissioned officers of the National Resistance Army. During this time Museven asked Habyalimana to allow three senior officers from his Army to join the Rwanda Army namely, Fred Rwegyerna Mugisha Muntu and Paul Kagame. Habyaiimana refused.

Museven asked Habyalimana to allow ordinary Batusi soldiers to join the Rwandan army from the National Resistance army he also refused, Museven also asked Habyalimana to allow Batusi civilians to go back to Rwanda. Habyalimana agreed on a base that those who had no criminal record could be allowed to go back on a small base.

Museven also asked habyalimana to open the borders to let business men and women trade between two countries Habyalimana agreed towards, the end of 1986 Museven sent the three thousand Batusi and Bahima who were trained in Rwenzori barracks to Rwanda in disguise of the civilians which Habyalimana agreed to allow go back to Rwarda. Museveri gave 300,000 Ugandan shillings to each one to help them settle in a new country.

This group of three thousand trained Army Batusi and Bahima were sending back information about Habyalimana's government and Army. In 1987 Jim Muhezi the director of internal security organisation appointed Stephen Ndaura Ssenoga At kyambogo technical college trained in communication to recruit and train all former Kyambogo in mate in the internal security organization.

All the recruited were immediately sent to East German and Cuba to train in operating newly intelligence equipment Kibuka was in charge of those who went to East German and Kayemba was in charge of those who went to Cuba. The two groups came back with a lot of intelligence equipment after six month. All these equipment where stored at the internal security organisation headquarters Nakasero. Stephen Nalura, Stephen Kweringira, David Kasula, Bosco Kiviri were in charge of these equipments. In December 1987 the internal security organisation bought (12) twelve mobile radios and IFA vehicles which carried them. They also bought (20) twenty thousand walkie-talkies and budging equipment from East Germany and twenty thousand sta^y pistols 6.71 mm carible all these were destined to Rwanda war. In 1986 Batumbya a Bulemezi farmer who helped Museven in the Bush war with food and cows was appointed by the high command to be the director of National Resistance Army farms
