Kabaka is in grave danger.

The Inspector-General of Uganda's Police, Major-General Kale Kayihura, last week called a press conference in Kampala to announce that the police has credible information that the life of the Kabaka (King) of Buganda, Ronald Muwenda Mutebi, was in danger. **I must mention that the police got this information after it was first broadcasted on radiomunansi.com, that Museveni was planning to kill the Buganda King**

Kayihura said some elements that he did not name planned to assassinate the *Kabaka*. The government of President Yoweri Museveni is preparing to give the *Kabaka* additional security. A long-time *Uganda Record* source says he has information on what is behind this latest development. **But our sources told us that the Ugandan dictator is in full panic mode, afraid that if the Kabaka of Buganda flees the country it might cause him and his government grave danger and this is the reason to why extra security was given, not to protect the King but to deter his escape or fleeing..**

"Like I told you recently, there was a slow but highly planned and well-calculated attack on Besigye. The media has come out extremely loudly to now start mentioning assassinations of the Kabaka but I can assure you this is direct from Tinyefuza that there are detailed plans to put the King of Buganda under full-scale class one detention on the pretext of the "Kabaka's life is in danger. I can speak without fear or favor that the Kabaka's life is not in any danger at all. Museveni knows and is totally afraid of the Kabaka's influence on the Buganda vote. He has ordered Tinyefuza to fix the Baganda once and for all," the source said

The source added: "[An intelligence officer] told me that this is just one of the major plans in the pipeline. Soon there will be an attack but this time more sophisticated than the World Cup bombings. And the cultural leaders' bill is to hoodwink the elite and divert their attention from the voter-buying."

As the *Uganda Record* stated in July 2010 and the U.S. Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) proved in their probe (but so far the U.S. government is afraid of publishing), the July 11, 2010 twin bombings in the Ugandan capital were not planned or carried out by the Somali militant group Al-Shabab, but in fact by Ugandan intelligence.

Meanwhile, information reaching the *Uganda Record* indicates that there was more to the bribe offer of 1.5 billion shillings bribe that President Museveni's son-in-law, Odrek Rwabwogo, had planned to give the Mayor of Hoima town, Francis Atugonza.

The money, says a source, was actually meant for the *Omukama* (King) of Bunyoro, Solomon Iguru, with Rwabwogo as the go-between.

To most observers, it seemed strange that State House would wish to bribe a Mayor of a small town and who even in opposition politics is a relatively minor factor.
