MANY primary schools implementing the UPE programme in Masaka, Kalungu and other neighboring districts continue to operate in appalling conditions! Although education takes up the largest share of the national budget, the increased funding has not always led to better outcomes due to system leakages, wastage, misuse of resources and corruption. *But this is in words, education has never been a major issue of this dictator's concerns, in fact it has always taken the back seat. Please see below after 26 years in power.*

When Red Pepper visited Kimaanya, Nyendo Public, Ndegeya, St Bruno Sserunkuma, St Noah Lugozi, Lugeye Muslim, Katyo Catholic and Bulungi Bwabazadde Primary Schools in Kalungu and Masaka districts, the education facilities could be mistaken for sties. With a population of 830 pupils at Katyo Catholic School, there are only 14 teachers and three benches. The dilapidated pit latrines are shared by both pupils and teachers who at times collide during 'rush hours'. 90 per cent of the lessons are conducted under trees and whenever it rains, pupils are sent back home. At Bulungi Bwabazadde Primary School in Kalungu district, 11 teachers struggle to teach 539 pupils. "At times, we close the school at 2:00pm to have time for ourselves," a disgruntled teacher who preferred anonymity said.
