## What is she really complaining about? *Kyambadde threatens to sue Mutuluuza*

### **Museveni is one of my funders, says NRM rising star. *NRM rising star????***

Peter Mutuuza said that his political opponent in the Mawokota parliamentary seat, is being funded at the tax payer's expense directly from the state house at the orders of strong man Museveni.

Now Dictator Museveni's crony Amelia Kyambadde is threatening to sue her opponent for speaking the truth in the campaign race! Why is this so? North is financed mainly by President Museveni in his personal capacity, as well as some friendly businessmen in Kampala.

Kyambadde's announcement, made at a rally in Mpigi Town Council on September 22, was meant to dispel claims by her opponent Mutuluza, that she is using public money to finance her campaign.

Mutuluza accused Kyambadde of using state resources to fund her campaign during a meeting with President Museveni at State House Entebbe on September 16.

The meeting, attended by about 600 people from Mawokota North, was convened by the President to restore harmony in the constituency where Mutuluza insists in running as an independent, having refused to contest in the primaries that handed Kyambadde the NRM flag.

"I am not going to stand down for this woman. I feel hurt. She has been using government money to campaign, and it is clear that the ground is not leveled..." Mutuluza reportedly said during the meeting.

But Kyambadde told Mawokota North voters that her record in public service remains clean as she has never been accused of abusing public funds. She said she is a person of integrity, adding that her witnesses include her former boss, President Museveni.

"My opponent, Claver Mutuluza, is making false accusations that I am using government money to finance my campaigns. And if I am really doing it, why is it that I am not spending that money to solve my personal problems?" she said.

Kyambadde added: "I would like to make it clear to [Mutuluza] that as Amelia, I have many friends and well-wishers who finance me and these include Gordon Wavamunno of Spear Motors, Hardware World, Finca Uganda, and I sometimes lobby from government institutions."

Kyambadde added that as a good leader, she has mobilised resources for the development of Mawokota.

"You should know that it's only a good leader who can beg from government with

success. If he [Mutuluza] cannot beg and deliver the needed development to his people, then what is he still doing in Parliament?" she said.

During the same function, Kyambadde launched a branch of her local association, Twezimbe Development Association, to which she donated 66 bicycles.

She defended the fact that as a person, the President can donate to needy people. "President Museveni is a human being and, like any other person, he can donate to the needy, and if he does, it does not mean that he uses government funds," she said.

She challenged Mutuluza to provide evidence that she spends government money in her campaigns.

Kyambadde also lashed out at Mutuluza, saying the MP has nothing to show the people of Mawokota North for the 10 years he has been in Parliament.

She threatened to drag him to court if he continued tarnishing her reputation which she said she has built for over 30 years of dedicated service.
